Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 13.3.2019 amending Commission Delegated Regulation [C(2019)1841 of 12 March 2019] supplementing Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the functioning of the Union Registry as regards the functioning of the Union Registry under Regulation (EU) 2018/842 of the European Parliament and of the Council

– Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and in particular the Article 12(1) of Regulation (EU) 2018/842 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2018 on binding annual greenhouse gas emission reductions by Member States from 2021 to 2030 contributing to climate action to meet commitments under the Paris Agreement and amending Regulation (EU) No 525/2013². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 13 March 2019, the Council may object to it until 13 May 2019.

2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act through an informal written procedure and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object it.
 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommends that the Council confirms that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 2 of the Delegated Regulation.
