Subject:	Draft Council Decision on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union at the fourteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and their Disposal with regard to certain amendments of Annexes II, VIII and IX thereto - Adoption

1. On 23 January 2019, the Commission submitted to Council a proposal for a Council Decision on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union at the fourteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and their Disposal with regard to certain amendments of Annexes II, VIII and IX thereto ¹.

2. On 7 February 2019, the Working Party on International Environment Issues (WPIEI) examined the Commission's proposal. On 18 February and 11 March 2019, the Working Party on the Environment (WPE) considered the proposal. The Presidency compromise text resulting from these discussions (doc. 7575/19) was circulated to delegations for agreement under an informal silence procedure ending on 20 March 2019, which was broken by three delegations. Subsequently, the Presidency submitted a revised compromise proposal (doc. 7575/1/19 REV 1) to delegations for agreement under an informal silence procedure.
3. The result of the last informal silence procedure ending on 22 March 2019 shows that the last Presidency compromise text, as set out in document 7863/19 following the legal-linguistic revision, is acceptable to all delegations.
4. The Committee of Permanent Representatives is invited to recommend that the Council:
 - adopt the Decision as set out in document 7863/19 as an "A" item at its meeting on 15 April 2019;
 - inform the European Parliament on its Decision in accordance with Article 218(10) of the TFEU.
