can be secured within the agreed expenditure ceiling of heading 1a of the multiannual financial framework for the period 2014-2020. The annual amount and the establishment plan posts for ACER, EIOPA and ENISA for the financial year 2019 have already been included in the 2019 budget, whereas the annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for ACER, EIOPA and ENISA for the financial year 2020 will be decided in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure.

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- The financing of the amounts presented in the revised financial statement for the *European Labour Authority* (ELA) and for the *European Securities and Markets Authority* (ESMA) related to the Central Clearing Counterparties (CCPs), can be secured within the agreed expenditure ceiling of heading 1a of the multiannual financial framework for the period 2014-2020. The annual amount and the establishment plan posts for ELA and ESMA for the financial year 2019 have already been included in the 2019 budget, whereas the annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for ELA and ESMA for the financial year 2020 will be decided in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure. The annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for ELA and ESMA for the post-2020 period are without prejudice to the decisions on the next multiannual financial framework.
- The financing of the amounts presented in the revised financial statement for the *Interoperability of IT systems* can be secured within the agreed expenditure ceiling of heading 3 of the multiannual financial framework for the period 2014-2020, which may entail the use of special instruments as defined in the MFF Regulation. The annual amount and the establishment plan posts related to *Interoperability* for EU-LISA and EUROPOL for the financial year 2019 have already been included in the 2019 budget, whereas the annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for EU-LISA, EUROPOL and CEPOL for the financial year 2020 will be decided in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure. The annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for EU-LISA, EUROPOL, CEPOL and FRONTEX for the post-2020 period are without prejudice to the decisions on the next multiannual financial framework.

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The financing of the amounts presented in the financial statement for the *European Food Safety Authority (EFSA)* related to the revision of the General Food Law can be secured within the agreed expenditure ceiling of heading 3 of the multiannual financial framework for the period 2014-2020, which may entail the use of special instruments as defined in the MFF Regulation. The annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for EFSA for the financial year 2020 will be decided in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure. The annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for EFSA for the post-2020 period are without prejudice to the decisions on the next multiannual financial framework.

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
