Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 6.3.2019 supplementing Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards measures adopted by the International Civil Aviation Organisation for the monitoring, reporting and verification of aviation emissions for the purpose of implementing a global market-based measure – Decision to request an extension of the time-limit

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated regulation¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and in particular Article 28c of Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 October 2003 establishing a system for greenhouse gas emission allowance trading within the Union and amending Council Directive 96/61/EC².
2. The Commission notified the delegated regulation on 6 March 2019. In accordance with Article 23 of Directive 2003/87/EC, the Council may object to it up to 6 May 2019.

3. Following a consultation launched by the General Secretariat of the Council, a number of delegations provided comments on the delegated regulation.
 4. The Working Party on Environment examined the delegated regulation at its meeting on 4 April 2019 and agreed that further discussions and clarifications are needed, which would require an extension of the period of objection. The period of extension should be one month.
 5. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommends that the Council decides to extend the period for raising objections by one month and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof.
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
