Subject:	Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on certain aspects concerning contracts for the supply of digital content and digital services (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 9 December 2015 the Commission sent the above proposal¹ to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 27 April 2016².
3. The European Data Protection Supervisor delivered its opinion on 14 March 2017³.

4. On 26 March 2019 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁴.
5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
 - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 26/19, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with the United Kingdom abstaining;
 - decide that the statement in the addendum to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
