Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 14.3.2019 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2446 as regards the declaration of certain low-value consignments - Intention not to raise objections

---

1. On 14 March 2019, the Commission submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Articles 7(a), 160, and 284 of Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 October 2013 laying down the Union Customs Code<sup>1</sup> (UCC). The Commission having notified the delegated act on 14 March 2019, the Council may object to it until 15 May 2019.
2. The Working Party on Customs Union has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend to the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act, and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 284 of the UCC.
