#### 'I/A' ITEM NOTE

Subject: COUNCIL DECISION appointing members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Hungary

---

1. The Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers, by its Decision of 28 September 2018<sup>1</sup>. However, it remained to appoint certain members and alternate members at a later stage.
2. Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of two years.
3. Nominations of two members and one alternate member for Hungary, of the renewed Advisory Committee, have been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 8419/19<sup>3</sup>.
