Subject: Summary of discussions

1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda as set out in CM 2557/2/19 REV 2 was adopted.

2. Information from the Presidency

The CCWP took note of the information provided by the Presidency on documents and past and upcoming meetings relevant to the work of the CCWP, as set out in WK 4900/19.

3. Review of the "JCO Guide"

a) Approval of the tactical objectives

The Presidency presented its proposal for amendments of the tactical objectives in the JCO Guide as set out in 7933/3/19 REV 3. The Swedish and the German delegations entered scrutiny reservations and asked for more time to look at the amendments; the Swedish delegation also asked for written explanations of the amendments.

b) Revision of JCO Strategic Objectives

The Presidency presented its proposal for amendments of the strategic objectives in the JCO Guide as set out in 8428/1/19 REV 1. The Swedish delegation entered a scrutiny reservation.

4. Central Coordination Units (CCU) - Steering Group outcomes

The Dutch delegation gave a presentation on the outcome of the CCU meeting in Vienna 2018 and the Steering group meeting in Brussels in March 2019.

5. Action 9.4 "Fight against illicit cash movements" – Interim report

The Italian delegation presented its report on the progress of Action 9.4 "Fight against illicit cash movements".

6. Action 9.7 "Better integration of customs in the EU SOCTA" – an update

The Swedish delegation presented the preliminary findings of Action 9.7 "Better integration of customs in the EU SOCTA".

7. Customs pre-arrival security and safety programme – ICS2 system - Status of the development

The Commission (DG TAXUD) presented the ICS2 programme – a new platform for customs policy delivery.

8. Illicit tobacco trade – assessment, trends and risks from an investigative perspective

The Commission (OLAF) made a presentation on illicit tobacco trade.

9. SIS & VIS questionnaire results

The Presidency presented the results of the replies received so far on the SIS & VIS questionnaire.

10. One Year of PNR – Questionnaire

The Presidency presented its questionnaire on the implementation of the PNR Directive, which is set out in 8430/19. Delegations were invited to submit comments on the text of the questionnaire at the latest by 26 April 2019.

11. Any other business

The delegations did not raise any issues under AOB.
