Subject: Summary of discussions

1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda as set out in CM 5316/1/17 was adopted.

2. Information from the Presidency

The CCWP took note of the information provided by the Presidency on documents and past and upcoming meetings relevant to the work of the CCWP, as set out in WK 14702/17.

3. The Tobacco Laboratory (TOBLAB)

The Commission made a presentation on the Tobacco Laboratory (TOBLAB) set up on the basis of an administrative Arrangement between OLAF and the Joint Research Center (JRC). TOBLAB has two main purposes, firstly to discriminate counterfeit cigarettes from genuine cigarettes and, secondly to establish links between similar counterfeit products.

- JCO Postbox (Action 8.2) - approval

- Customs against internet crime (Action 8.2)

The CCWP approved the draft final report on JCO Cerberus set out in document 14540/17 RESTRICTED EU.

- Cash Movements (Action 8.3)

The CCWP approved the draft final report on Action 8.3 - control of cash movements set out in document 14541/1/17.

- Export of strategic goods (Action 8.5)

The CCWP approved the draft final report on Action 8.5 - Export of strategic goods - set out in document 14856/17.

- Central Coordination Unit (Action 8.7)

The CCWP approved the draft final report on Action 8.7 - Central Coordination Units set out in document 15147/17.

5. The EU Sanctions Map

The Presidency made a presentation on a new digital tool – the EU Sanctions Map developed by Estonia and launched on 19 September 2017. The EU Sanctions Map allows to visualise all sanctions regimes on a world map and it is intended to help users to access relevant and up-to-date information in just a few clicks.

6. Six months report of the former Maltese Presidency

MT presented a report on the main results and activities carried out under its term at the Presidency of the EU Council.

7. Priorities of the incoming BG Presidency

BG presented the priorities for the CCWP during the first semester of 2018. The incoming Presidency will focus on the preparation and approval of the mandates for actions retained under the 9th Action Plan. The dates for the meetings are as follows: 11 January (Experts), 31 January (Plenary), 14 February (Plenary), 27 March (Experts), 12 April (Plenary), 22 May (Experts) and 19 June (Plenary).
