Subject: European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 6/2019: "Tackling fraud in EU cohesion spending: managing authorities need to strengthen detection, response and coordination"

- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 16 May 2019, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 6/2019 entitled "Tackling fraud in EU cohesion spending: managing authorities need to strengthen detection, response and coordination"¹.
2. Under the rules laid down in the Council conclusions on improving the examination of special reports drawn up by the Court of Auditors², it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee instruct the Working Party on Structural Measures to examine the report in accordance with those rules.
