Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../...of 14.3.2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council by establishing classes of performance in relation to resistance to wind load for external blinds and awnings - Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and 60 (f) of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011² laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC. The delegated act is based on Article 27 (1) of that Regulation. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 14 March 2019, the Council has until 14 June 2019 to object to it.

2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation has examined the delegated act by written procedure until 15 April 2019 and at a Working Party meeting on 22 May 2019 and has concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
 3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011.
