Subject: Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing a European Labour Authority, amending Regulations (EC) No 883/2004, (EU) No 492/2011, and (EU) 2016/589 and repealing Decision (EU) 2016/344 **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 13 March 2018 the Commission sent the above proposal¹, based on Article 46, Article 48, Article 53(1), Article 62 and Article 91(1) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 20 September 2018².
3. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 9 October 2018³.

4. On 16 April 2019 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁴.
5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
 - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 49/19, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with Austria, Hungary and Sweden voting against and the Czech Republic and Poland abstaining;
 - decide that the statements in Addenda 1 and 2 to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting;
 - decide to publish the statement in Addendum 1 in the Official Journal of the European Union.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
