As per previous practices, each Member State can designate **one delegate participating in the Working Party on e-Law (e-Justice) and two representatives of the judiciary** to attend the meeting of the Cooperation Mechanism. Travel costs of the participants (including the representatives of the judiciary) designated by the Member States will be reimbursed in the same way as in the case of any other Working Party meeting of the Council.

Delegations are invited to coordinate within themselves, in order to ensure that not all participants attend the same morning panel.

2. Morning session: parallel panels

- Legal challenges of e-Procedures, notably:
 - Adaptation of procedural law to electronic means of communication
 - Notification and communication between citizens, practitioners and Courts
 - Management of procedures in electronic form: validity and opposability of acts, publicity of procedures
 - Access to electronic justice: Justice data, e-ID and e-Courts
- Technical challenges of e-Procedures, notably:
 - Challenges of migrating to e-Procedures
 - Implementation of electronic procedures in Member States
 - Creation of case managements systems
 - Security of communication between citizens, practitioners and Courts

3. Afternoon session: consolidation of discussions

- Conciliation between legal and technical challenges of e-Procedures
- Promotion of e-Procedures: access to Courts and streamlining of Justice
- Technical solutions: practicality for practitioners, usability by Courts
