Subject:	Transfer of appropriations No DEC 12/2019 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2019

1. On 28 June 2019, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 12/2019.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer a total amount of EUR 16.9 million in commitment and payment appropriations from Article 40 02 41 (*Differentiated appropriations*), to Article 11 03 01 (*Establishing a governance framework for fishing activities carried out by Union fishing vessels in third country waters*), as recorded in document 10821/19.

2. The aim of this transfer is to cover the financial contributions as outlined in the three protocols implementing the Sustainable Fisheries Partnerships Agreements between the EU and the Republic of Cape Verde, the Republic of Guinea Bissau and the Republic of Gambia.

3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 5 July 2019.
 4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
