Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 23.11.2017
amending Regulation (EU) No 347/2013 of the European Parliament and of
the Council as regards the Union list of projects of common interest
- Intention not to raise objections to a Delegated Act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 16 of Regulation (EU) No 347/2013 on guidelines for trans-European energy infrastructure². The Commission having notified the delegated act amending Regulation (EU) No 347/2013 as regards the Union list of projects of common interest on 24 November 2017, the Council may object to it until 25 January 2018.

2. Delegations were invited to express their intention about the present delegated act by 22 December 2017.³ No objections were raised by this date.
3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 16 of Regulation (EU) No 347/2013.
