THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3924/91 of 19 December 1991 on the establishment of a Community survey of industrial production¹, and in particular Article 2(6) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In accordance with Regulation (EEC) No 3924/91 Member States should carry out a statistical survey of industrial production.
- (2) The survey should be based on a list of products identifying the relevant industrial production.
- (3) A list of products is necessary for the alignment between production statistics and external trade statistics and for the comparison with the Union product nomenclature CPA (Classification of Products by Activity).
- (4) The list of products required by Regulation (EEC) No 3924/91 (‘the “Prodcom list”’), is common to all Member States, and is necessary for the purposes of the comparability of data across Member States.
- (5) In order to reflect the technological development and structural changes of the industrial production, it is necessary to establish an updated Prodcom list.
- (6) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the European Statistical System Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The Prodcom list shall be as set out in the Annex.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

It shall apply from 1 January 2019.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
