Statement by Luxembourg

"Luxembourg fully supports the aims of the Horizontal WP on Enhancing Resilience and Countering Hybrid Threats. It notes that many of the concepts to be addressed within the said WP are still to be defined.

In particular, the Luxembourg authorities would like to underline that any conflation between hybrid threats and the general phenomenon of disinformation must be avoided. While disinformation can at times be used in the context of hybrid threats, this is not always the case. Countering disinformation should under no circumstances be used as a pretext to interfere in freedom of expression, freedom of the media or other fundamental rights.

Luxembourg will also continue to insist on avoiding any duplications with other WP so as to create a clearer delimitation between their respective tasks."

Statement by Hungary

"Hungary recalls its declaration of 16 January 2019 on the legal consequences of the judgement of the Court of Justice in ACHMEA and on investment protection in the European Union.

We also recall the opinion of the Council Legal Service that the European Commission cannot decide which of the diverging positions are the right one, and on the basis of the principle of loyal cooperation the European Commission can only indicate that the interpretations of the Member States differ in this respect.

Therefore in international arbitration procedures the European Commission can only indicate that the interpretations of the Member States differ in respect of the Energy Charter Treaty."
