Subject: European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 20/2017: "EU-funded loan guarantee instruments: positive results but better targeting of beneficiaries and coordination with national schemes needed"

- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 7 December 2017, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 20/2017 entitled "EU-funded loan guarantee instruments: positive results but better targeting of beneficiaries and coordination with national schemes needed"¹.
