Subject:	COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of XXX amending Regulation (EC) No 1881/2006 as regards maximum levels of citrinin in food supplements based on rice fermented with red yeast <i>Monascus purpureus</i> - <i>Decision not to oppose adoption</i>

1. On 11 July 2019, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and by the Council the above draft Regulation, in accordance with Article 5a (3)(a) of Council Decision No 1999/468/EC¹, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission².
2. The Working Party on Foodstuffs considered, through an informal written procedure³, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to:
 - confirm the agreement reached by the Working Party, and
 - recommend to the Council to confirm, as an "A" item on its agenda, that there are no grounds for opposing the draft measures.
