Subject:	Draft Council Conclusions on the European Case Law Identifier (ECLI) and a minimum set of uniform metadata for case law - Including ECLI 2.0
	- Adoption

- On 29 April 2011, were published after their adoption by Council, the Council conclusions inviting the introduction of the European Case Law Identifier (ECLI) and a minimum set of uniform metadata for case law.¹
- 2. Due to the advancements in technology since then, the need for a new version of these Conclusions became evident in the following years. Notably, work was conducted for the development of ECLI 2.0.
- 3. The draft Council Conclusions on ECLI incorporate the work on ECLI 2.0. It was discussed within the Expert group on ECLI and during the meeting of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) on 22 May 2019. Modifications were accepted through informal silent procedure until 11 July 2019.
