Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 15.12.2017 on key elements of data storage contracts to be concluded as part of a traceability system for tobacco products
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. On 15 December 2017, the Commission notified the European Parliament and the Council of the adoption of the above Delegated Regulation in accordance with Article 15(12) of Directive No 2014/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council¹.
2. The Working Party on Public Health considered, through an informal written procedure², that there are no grounds for the Council to object to this delegated act.
