THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 October 2009 concerning the placing of plant protection products on the market and repealing Council Directives 79/117/EEC and 91/414/EEC¹, and in particular Article 29(6) and 84(d) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) An error appears in point C. 2.5.1.2. (i) of Part I of the Annex to Commission Regulation (EU) No 546/2011² which sets out the specific principles to be taken into consideration in the decision-making process as regards the concentration of the active substance and of relevant metabolites, degradation or reaction products in groundwater.
- (2) The error appeared when incorporating certain provisions of repealed Council Directive 91/414³ into Regulation (EU) No 546/2011 pursuant to Article 84(d) of Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009.
- (3) In the Annex to Council Directive 91/414, the reference was made to Council Directive 80/778/EC relating to the quality of water intended for human consumption⁴ and which was subsequently repealed and replaced by Council Directive 98/83/EC on the quality of water intended for human consumption⁵. Therefore, Regulation (EU) No 546/2011 should refer to Council Directive 98/83/EC and not to Directive 2006/118/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, which concerns the protection of groundwater against pollution and deterioration⁶.
- (4) Implementing Regulation (EU) No 546/2011 should therefore be corrected accordingly.

- (5) In order to ensure that the correct criteria for an appropriate implementation of the uniform principles are also applied to ongoing assessment procedures, this correction should apply as soon as possible.
- (6) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Commission Regulation (EU) No 546/2011 is corrected as follows:

In Part I of the Annex, point C. 2.5.1.2. (i) is replaced by the following:

- '(i) the maximum permissible concentration laid down by Council Directive 98/83/EC*; or

- (*) Council Directive 98/83/EC of 3 November 1998 on the quality of water intended for human consumption (OJ L 330, 5.12.1998, p. 32).'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
