## NOTE VERBALE

The Directorate-General for Trade of the European Commission presents its compliments to the Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union and, in accordance with the Conclusions of the European Council in Essen, has the honour to inform it that the European Commission has received a request for a review of the anti-dumping measures concerning imports of certain tube and pipe fittings of iron or steel originating in Turkey.

The complaint was lodged by the Defence Committee of the steel butt-welding fittings industry of the European Union on behalf of EU producers representing a major proportion of the EU production of the product concerned.

The products concerned are described as tube and pipe fittings (other than cast fittings, flanges and threaded fittings), of iron or steel (not including stainless steel), with a greatest external diameter not exceeding 609,6 mm, of a kind used for butt-welding or other purposes. It is indicated in the complaint that the products under consideration fall within CN codes: ex 7307 93 11, ex 7307 93 19 and ex 7307 99 80.

With regard to dumping, it is claimed by the complainant that export prices based on several offers and Eurostat are considerably lower than normal value based on Turkish price list. On this basis, it is alleged that a dumping margin of 10% for exports from Turkey exists. The exporting producers identified in the request are listed in the attached document.

The injury caused by the allegedly dumped imports from Turkey consists of heavy losses, production, capacity utilisation, sales and market share decrease.

The Commission's services are currently examining this complaint and the supporting evidence submitted in order to assess whether the initiation of an anti-dumping proceeding is warranted. This examination will be concluded with 45 days after the lodging date of the complaint.

Should the European Commission decide to initiate a review investigation, information, including copies of the notice of initiation and the request for review, will be provided to the Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union immediately upon publication of the notice of initiation of the review investigation in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

The Directorate-General for Trade of the European Commission wishes to bring to the attention of the Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union that should the investigation be initiated, in view of the potentially large number of exporting producers in Turkey involved and in order to complete the investigation within the statutory time-limits, the Commission may limit the exporting producers that will be investigated to a reasonable number by selecting a sample. In such a case, the Commission's services would appreciate the cooperation of the Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union in the selection of a representative sample of exporting producers.

In addition, please find attached the above-mentioned list with the exporting producers that have been identified in the request. The Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union is requested to check this list for accuracy and completeness and to provide the Commission with the names and addresses of any other exporting producers that may be concerned but are not listed in the request no later than 26 January 2018 so that, should the European Commission decide to initiate a review investigation, it can contact them. The Commission appreciates the collaboration of the Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union in ensuring that all exporting producers have full opportunity to cooperate in the investigation.

The Directorate-General for Trade of the European Commission takes this opportunity to renew to the Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union the assurance of its highest consideration, and to notify that it will keep the Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the European Union duly informed of any further developments.
