Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 16.12.2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council by specifying the number and the titles of the variables for the income and living conditions domain
- intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. On 16 December 2019, the Commission submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 6 of Regulation (EU) 2019/1700².
2. No objections were raised by delegations during the silence procedure that expired on 31 January 2020.

2 Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 10 October 2019 establishing a common framework for European statistics relating to persons and households, based on data at individual level collected from samples, amending Regulations (EC) No 808/2004, (EC) No 452/2008 and (EC) No 1338/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1177/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Regulation (EC) No 577/98, OJ L 261I, 14.10.2019, p. 1.

3. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee could invite the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act, and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act, as set out in doc. ST 15199/19, shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 17 of Regulation (EU) 2019/1700.
