## OUTCOME OF PROCEEDINGS

### 1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted, as set out in CM 3467/22.

### 2. Information by the Presidency

The Presidency informed about the state of play of ongoing files:

- the approval of the Council Conclusions "Protecting Europeans from terrorism: achievements and next steps" (9997/22) at the JHA-June Council; and
- COSI's endorsement of the six-monthly threat assessment (9495/22) together with the revised (mainly simplified) procedure on enhanced security checks on persons having crossed or crossing the external borders of the EU as a result of developments in Afghanistan (9496/22).

### **3. Exchange of views: focus on violent anti-government movements**

10133/22 (R-UE/EU-R)

Following presentations by INTCEN and a Member State, delegations held an exchange of views. The deadline for possible further comments is 1 July 2022.

### **4. Exchange of views: challenges posed by individuals posing a violent terrorist/extremist threat and with mental health disorders**

10134/22 (R-UE/EU-R)

Member States had a brief exchange of views on the abovementioned topic.

### **5. Information on CT and CVE incidents**

The Presidency presented the ENFOPOL grid to which five Member States had contributed. Furthermore one delegation summarised a recent repatriation of women and children from Syria, and another delegation informed about a recent conviction of a woman having joined Daesh.

### **6. Information on activities related to CT and CVE incidents**

The Commission, EEAS, the EU CTC and Europol updated delegations on recent and upcoming CT and CVE-related activities.

### **7. Priorities of the incoming Presidency**

The incoming Czech Presidency presented its priorities for the coming half year.

### **8. AOB**

Implementation of Regulation (EU) 2021/784 on combating the dissemination of terrorist content online: progress report.

The Regulation applying from 7 June 2022, Member States who had not yet notified the Commission as requested were encouraged to do so as quickly as possible.

Next TWP-meeting, the first under the incoming Czech Presidency, will take place on 14 July 2022.
