

Dear Madam,

I refer to my previous notification on 1 September 2021 where I informed you, on behalf of the Icelandic government, that Iceland accepted the content of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing, as part of the Integrated Border Management Fund, the Instrument for Financial Support for Border Management and Visa Policy, Council document: PE-CONS 57/21. The acceptance was based on Article 8(2a) of the Agreement concluded by the Council of the European Union and the Republic of Iceland and the Kingdom of Norway concerning the latters' association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen Acquis.

As Iceland has yet to fulfill constitutional requirements to be able to accept the content based on before mentioned Article 8(2a), I hereby send corrected notification, on behalf of the Icelandic government, that Iceland has accepted the content of the said regulation, according to Article 8 paragraph 2(b). I take the opportunity also of informing you that Iceland will make its notification under Article 8(2a), after the fulfilment of constitutional requirements. I apologize for the inconvenience this may cause.

The Icelandic Mission to the European Union avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union the assurances of its highest consideration.
