Please note that no admission to the discussion on the EU CONFIDENTIAL item(s) will be granted to delegates for whose clearances the GSC Safety and Security Directorate has no record or who cannot present a valid, original personnel security clearance certificate issued by their National Security Authorities or by other competent national authorities.

It is in the interest of the participants to ensure that their personnel security clearance has not expired.
