Subject:	Draft COUNCIL DECISION appointing the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Denmark, Germany, Greece, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta and Portugal

1. The Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers, by its Decision of 20 September 2022¹ However, it remained to appoint certain members and alternate members at a later stage.
2. Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union², and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of two years.
3. Several nominations of members and alternate members for Denmark, Germany, Greece, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta and Portugal, of the renewed Advisory Committee, have been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 12876/22³.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee could therefore suggest that the Council:
- (a) adopts the Council Decision appointing the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Denmark, Germany, Greece, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta and Portugal, as an "A" item, and
 - (b) decides to publish the Decision for information in the Official Journal of the European Union.
