**Joint statement on the the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity (ENISA), the European Securities and Market Authority (ESMA) and the European Banking Authority (EBA)**

“In accordance with Point 27 of the Interinstitutional Agreement (IIA) of 20 December 2020, the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission agree on the following, on the basis of the information transmitted by the Commission:

- The financing of the amounts presented in:
  - the financial statement for the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity (ENISA) related to measures for a high common level of cybersecurity across the Union; and
  - in the revised financial statement for the European Securities and Market Authority (ESMA), and the European Banking Authority (EBA) related to the European framework for markets in crypto assets

can be secured within the agreed expenditure ceiling of heading 1 of the multiannual financial framework for the period 2021-2027. The annual amount and the establishment plan posts for ENISA, ESMA, and EBA for the financial year 2022 have already been included in the 2022 budget. The annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for ENISA, ESMA, and EBA for the financial years 2023-2027 will be decided in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure.”
