### 1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted, as set out in CM 4588/1/22 REV 1.

### 2. PNR: Travel intelligence and risk person identification (from the CT and CVE points of view). Examples of good practice

As a follow-up to last meetings' presentations on the topic and a summary of the written comments received to the questions set out in 11846/22, delegates had an exchange of views.

The deadline for further written comments is 21 October 2022.

### 3. Ukraine

Delegates had a brief exchange of views following presentations and interventions by IntCen, the Office of the EU CTC, the Commission, EEAS, Europol, Czechia and Romania.

The deadline for possible written comments to the questions contained in 12869/1/22 REV 1 is 21 October 2022.

#### **4. EU threat assessment**

IntCen and Europol presented their recent assessments/report EEAS (2022) 10491, EEAS (2022) 10492 and 13389/22 (*all to be issued*). On the basis thereof, a draft threat assessment will be shared with Member States for written comments before the next meeting.

#### **5. List of the FTFs and TWP protocol**

France presented its national approach in dealing with the above-mentioned lists.

#### **6. Council conclusions: “Protecting Europeans from terrorism: achievements and next steps” – a debate on the next steps**

Based on 9997/22 and interventions by the Commission and France, delegations held a brief exchange of views.

#### **7. Violent anti-system extremism**

The office of the EU CTC presented its paper on violent anti-system extremism, see 13177/22 (later amended by COR 1). On the basis thereof, delegations had an exchange of views.

The deadline for possible comments to the paper is 28 October 2022.

#### **8. Information on CT and CVE incidents**

Three Member States had reported incidents in the reporting period to the Presidency (ENFOPOL grid), and one delegation orally referred to a shooting incident which had taken place on 12 October 2022.

#### **9. Information on activities related to CT and CVE**

The Commission, EEAS, the EU CTC and Europol updated delegations on recent and upcoming CT and CVE-related activities.

#### **10. Any other business**

Next TWP-meeting will take place on 14-15 November 2022; the afternoon of 15 November will be dedicated to a joint meeting with COTER.
