Subject:	Support for and Solidarity with Ukrainian culture, including cultural heritage

In the context of the preparations for the policy debate to take place at the Education, Youth, Culture and Sport Council meeting on 29 November 2022 (see doc. 14437/1/22 REV 1), the Presidency has been in contact with the Ukrainian Ministry of Culture, which has set out its main needs regarding cultural reconstruction. This information, which is of an informal indicative nature, is set out in Annex I and Annex II to this Note<sup>1</sup>.

### 1. SUPPORT TO UKRAINIAN ARTISTS, CULTURAL MANAGERS AND JOURNALISTS

80% of artists, cultural managers and journalists are staying and working in Ukraine. Our cultural institutions have experienced sharp drop in their usual revenues despite the fact the many of them are working now with their audiences. We have estimated this drop as a 40% decline. That means that institutions cannot fulfil their obligations and pay utilities and wages in full. Furthermore, financial support from the local and state budgets is also tightened as the priority funding now is defence and social security.

Support to cultural sphere in the form of grants to institutions or stipends for individual artists is of utmost importance for Ukraine now to protect the consistency of artistic activity, cultural expression, which is the base for social cohesion and communities' resilience. This support could be realized through the well-established institution − **Ukrainian Cultural Foundation** (www.ucf.in.ua). The total amount of funding envisaged for the distribution by the UCF for 2022 was more than €20 mln. Unfortunately, due to the state budget sequestration, this amount was almost completely cut, leaving wages for the team unchanged. The UCF with their wide experts' network is ready to work in collaboration with any other international organization to provide the full-cycle support in applications' accepting, assessment and grants or stipends distribution process.

### 2. SUPPORT TO UKRAINIAN PUBLISHERS AND LIBRARIES

We would be grateful for the support of Ukrainian publishers within Ukraine. As many creative industries in the country they are experiencing sharp drop in revenues, loss of people working in their teams, deficit of the materials and logistics problems. The **Ukrainian Book Institute** is the main institution providing support to Ukrainian publishers and is replenishing the Ukrainian libraries' book funds. For 2022 the total amount of the UIB was planned at the level of around €10 **mln**, with strategic plans of promoting Ukrainian literature abroad, granting support to local publishers, providing grants for foreign publishers for translation of Ukrainian literature into European languages. As you know, this budget was also cut during the state budget sequestrations. So, your support through the UIB would be invaluable for Ukrainian publishing sector.

## 3. MEDIA SUPPORT AND COORDINATION VIA "INFORMATIONAL RAMMSTEIN"

Independent media in Ukraine are now facing the question of survival. Advertising market, the main source of revenues, has dropped by 70% for printed and online media, by 90% for TV and radio. About 40% of personnel were laid off. Supporting the sustainability and operational capacity of Ukrainian media is of utmost importance not only for our country, but for the whole civilized world, as they are fighting at the informational front. Ukrainian Centre of Strategic Communication works to debunk Russian propaganda, disinformation and fakes. With these poisoning messages Russia deceives the whole world. That is why it's so important to coordinate our efforts in fighting propagandistic and fake news. "Informational Rammstein" could become a platform for quick coordination, exchange of data and experience in countering information threats.

We would like to ask to initiate establishing of the **unified European cultural fund** dedicated to urgent support to Ukrainian culture and media during the war. We strongly believe that this initiative would help to safeguard the European cultural heritage and to preserve cultural diversity in Europe. Total amount of funds necessary for cultural and media sphere in Ukraine is estimated at €250 mln:

- support to Ukrainian cultural institutions and media (and indirectly to Ukrainian artists,
   cultural mangers, journalists) which could be realized via Ukrainian Cultural Foundation and
   Ukrainian Book Institute: €50 mln in 2022.
- urgent protection for cultural institutions and cultural heritage sites before the winter
   (conservation works to protect damaged buildings, electric generators, emergency equipment like fire extinguishers, humidifiers, air dryers, electric heaters, etc.): €65 mln in 2022.
- digitalisation projects: €5 mln in 2022.
- assessing damages, designing and preparatory works before the restoration, restoration works at more than 800 cultural institutions: €130 mln in 2023-2024.
