1. The Presidency intends to invite the following third parties to the meeting of the Working Party on International Food and Agricultural Questions ((FAO) scheduled for 24 November 2022:
 - Head of the UN Food Systems Coordination Hub and Director of the Office of Sustainable Development Goals at the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO);
