Delegations will find in Annex a note from the Commission services on the above-mentioned subject to be dealt with at the meeting of the Special Committee on Agriculture on 5 December 2022.

The negotiating directives attached to Council Decision (EU) 2021/1345 authorising the opening of negotiations on agreements on trade in organic products between the European Union and Argentina, Australia, Canada, Costa Rica, India, Israel, Japan, New Zealand, the Republic of Korea, Tunisia and the United States of America provide that before initiating negotiations with the third countries concerned, the Commission shall inform the Special Committee on Agriculture of the Council of the European Union, and update it regularly on their progress.

Further information on the currently applicable unilateral recognitions is provided in Annex. Canada, Israel, Japan, New Zealand, Tunisia, the Republic of Korea and the United States have also recognised unilaterally the EU as having an equivalent system to their own.

Information will be provided by the Commission on the preparatory work carried out and the suggested approach and timelines for carrying out the negotiations. The members of the SCA will be kept regularly updated on the progress of the negotiations.
