Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX correcting the German language version of Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 implementing Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and implementing Council Directive 97/78/EC as regards certain samples and items exempt from veterinary checks at the border under that Directive

- *Decision not to oppose the adoption*

1. On 26 November 2019, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 14904/19) in accordance with Article 5a (3)(a) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC¹, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission².
2. The Working Party of Agricultural Counsellors considered through an informal written procedure³, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
