<u>Subject</u>: EFC recommendation for the renewal of the mandate of a Member of ESGAB

## Dear Minister Stanjura,

The European Statistical Governance Advisory Board (ESGAB) was established by Decision No 235/2008/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 March 2008. Its purpose is to provide an independent overview of the European Statistical System as regards the implementation of the European Statistics Code of Practice.

The Economic and Financial Committee has been consulted on the renewal of the mandate of an ESGAB Member Mr. Priit Potisepp. The Council appointed Mr. Potisepp for a period of three years, starting on 23 December 2019. The term of Mr. Potisepp, will come to an end on 22 December 2022. In accordance with Art. 3.4 of the Decision, Mr. Potisepp is eligible for a second term and has expressed the willingness to be renewed in the office.

Following this consultation, the Economic and Financial Committee recommends that the Council confirms Mr. Potisepp for a second term, endorsing the recommendation done by ESGAB.
