Subject: Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the labelling of tyres with respect to fuel efficiency and other parameters, amending Regulation (EU) 2017/1369 and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1222/2009 (**first reading**)  
- Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

---

1. On 17 May 2018 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 and Article 194(2) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 17 October 2018<sup>2</sup>.
3. The Committee of the Regions was consulted and decided not to issue an opinion.
4. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 26 March 2019<sup>3</sup>.

5. On 16 December 2019, the Agriculture and Fisheries Council reached a political agreement on the Council's position at first reading on the above draft Regulation<sup>4</sup>.
6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is asked to suggest that the Council adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 14649/19 and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 14649/19 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
