
Dear President,

By the present letter, I submit my resignation as member of the Panel foreseen by Article 255 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, with immediate effect.

I do this in view of the start of my new function as Secretary General of the European People's Party (EPP) in the European Parliament from 1 March. I believe that standing down from the Panel is necessary and ethically correct in order to exclude altogether any risk, whether real or perceived, of any conflict of interest whatsoever with my new function.
