Delegations are hereby informed that the written procedure for the adoption of the reply to the above-mentioned confirmatory application (see CM 5898/3/22 REV 3) was completed on 16 January 2023 and that:

- 2. the majority of the delegations agreed to the adoption of the reply to confirmatory application No 20/c/01/22 (reply annexed to document ST 15242/2/22 REV 2), with the Netherlands voting against and making the statement below;

## STATEMENT BY THE NETHERLANDS

The Netherlands cannot concur with the reasoning in the draft reply to confirmatory application No 20/c/01/22 that disclosure of the requested document would (seriously) undermine the protection of the public interests as regards the financial, monetary or economic policy of the Community or a Member State and the Council's decision-making process as well as the protection of legal advice and court proceedings. Considering the restrictive interpretation of these exceptions by the Court, the Netherlands believes that it is not sufficiently motivated that there is a reasonably foreseeable and not purely hypothetical risk that disclosure of the requested document would specifically and actually undermine the relevant interests (in light of the case law of the Court of Justice and in particular case C-350/12 P, Council/in 't Veld and joined cases C-39/05 P and C-52/05, Kingdom of Sweden and Turco/Council).
