Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED DIRECTIVE (EU) .../... of 16.12.2022 amending Directive 2000/53/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the exemptions for the use of lead in aluminium alloys for machining purposes, in copper alloys and in certain batteries - Intension not to raise objections

1. On 16 December 2022, the Commission submitted the above draft Delegated Directive to the Council in accordance with Article 4(2), point (b) of Directive 2000/53/EC¹ on the end-of-life vehicles (ELV Directive). For the purpose of adapting to technical progress, this Delegated Directive amends Annex II of the ELV Directive as regards an exemption for specific applications containing lead.

2. Delegations had until 31 January 2023 to object to the delegated act. By this deadline, no delegation raised any objection, nor made comments. After the two-month period for scrutiny expires on 17 February 2023, the delegated act will be adopted.

3. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to recommend to the Council to confirm the non-opposition to the draft Delegated Directive, as set out in document ST 16215/22 + ADD 1 as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
