OUTCOME OF PROCEEDINGS

Subject:	Summary of discussions Working Party on Terrorism (TWP) and Working Party on Terrorism (International Aspects, COTER) of 14 February 2023

1. Adoption of the Agenda

The provisional agenda, as set out in CM 3142/1/23, was adopted.

2. Undesirable foreign funding

Delegates had an exchange of view following presentations by France and the Netherlands focusing on the ongoing Project-Based Collaboration (PBC) on undesirable foreign funding, set up in the framework of the Radicalisation Awareness Network in May 2022 and supported by the Commission. The Office of the EU Counter-terrorism Coordinator and EEAS contributed to complete the overview of ongoing activities within the area. Among other things, the need for a common understanding of the phenomenon and continued exchange of best practices to address undesirable foreign funding was stressed.

3. Update on Ukraine and effects on the terrorist threat

Delegations received an update by IntCen (CONFIDENTIEL UE/EU CONFIDENTIAL), Europol, the Commission and Frontex on the situation in Ukraine and the impact on the terrorist threat.

4. Global Counterterrorism Forum

EEAS updated delegates on the activities Global Counterterrorism Forum (GCTF) in the light of EU's current role as a co-chair.

5. AOB

The Presidency informed delegates on the EU-US dialogue on Justice and Home Affairs, in view of the forthcoming Senior Officials Meeting of 16-17 March 2023. The agenda of the meeting is set out in 6037/23.
