- The Public Prosecutor's Office, in the case of investigations conducted by the Public Prosecutor's Office or in the case of penal proceedings against juveniles (el Ministerio Fiscal, si se tratara de diligencias de investigación sustanciadas ante la Fiscalía o de la instrucción de un proceso de responsabilidad penal de menores).
