Subject:	Council Decision appointing a member, proposed by Ireland, of the European Economic and Social Committee
	- Adoption

- By letter dated 15 April 2021¹, the President of the European Economic and Social Committee (EESC) notified the Council of the resignation of Ms Mary DOYLE, member of the EESC.
- 2. By letter dated 19 January 2023², the Government of Ireland proposed Mr Neil WALKER, *Head of Infrastructure, Energy and Environment, Irish Business and Employers*Confederation (IBEC), for appointment as a member of the EESC for the remainder of the current term of office, which runs until 20 September 2025.
- 3. Under Article 302 TFEU, the Council appoints the EESC's members after consulting the Commission.
