Subject:	Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers following an application from Spain (EGF/2022/003 ES/Alu Ibérica) – <i>Approval</i>

1. On 16 March 2023, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF), accompanied by the corresponding proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 04/2023<sup>1</sup>
2. The proposal aims to mobilise a total amount of EUR 1.3 million under the EGF to meet an application from Spain to deploy the Fund following workers' displacements in Alu Ibérica LC S.L, resulting from the increase in the prices of energy and raw materials, such as magnesium, together with the decline in world aluminum prices resulting from production overcapacity in China, in order to provide assistance for reintegrating the 303 targeted beneficiaries into the labour market, in line with Regulation (EU) 2021/691<sup>2</sup>.

3. The Budget Committee examined the proposal at its meeting on 22 March 2023 and was able to approve it.
