The SCA:

- considered the draft Council Decision contained in doc. 8972/23 and invited the Council:
  - to adopt it at its meeting on 8 June, under “A” items, after revision of the text by lawyer-linguists; and
  - to inform the European Parliament of its Decision in accordance with Article 218(10) of the TFEU;
- confirmed the Union position reached by consensus in the Working Party on the draft OIV resolutions of Union competence which would not have legal effects if adopted by the OIV, while agreeing, as set out in paragraph 9 of document 9025/23, that one of those resolutions would need to be discussed further on-the-spot in Spain.

**5. Conversion to a Farm Sustainability Data Network (FSDN)**  9067/23  
*Mandate for negotiations with the European Parliament*

The SCA agreed its negotiating position on the Regulation on Farm Sustainability Data Network by qualified majority. The negotiating position was set out in document number 9067/23, which would be made public. The agreement reached would allow the Presidency to start negotiations with the European Parliament, which had already agreed its position.

The SCA took note of the information provided by the Polish delegation on ‘Questions concerning the relationship between the draft SUR and the Common Agricultural Policy’, of the Commission’s response and related comments from Member States.

The Presidency informed the SCA on the next SCA meeting on 22 May and the “Agriculture and Fisheries” Council meeting on 30 May 2023.

As regards that “Agriculture and Fisheries” Council meeting:

- The Portuguese delegation requested an item under “any other business” on drought. The SCA subsequently agreed that this item would be held in public session in accordance with article 8(2) of the rules of procedure of the Council.
- The Croatian delegation requested an item under “any other business” on the review of the crisis management tools under the CMO Regulation.
