## **AOB** item requested by Slovenian for the FAC (26 June 2023)

The Convention on International Cooperation in the Investigation and Prosecution of the Crime of Genocide, Crimes against Humanity, War Crimes and other International Crimes, now known as Ljubljana-The Hague MLA Convention, has been adopted at the Diplomatic Conference in Ljubljana on 26 May 2023.

The adoption of the Convention seizes a historic opportunity to strengthen international legal cooperation in criminal matters and strengthen the fight against Impunity. It represents a landmark International Treaty that will help significantly reduce impunity for perpetrators of Genocide, Crimes against Humanity and War Crimes and deliver justice to victims of some of the worst atrocities known to humankind.
