#### f) Organisation of future work

The Presidency informed the SCA the "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting on 26-27 June 2023.

As regards that "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting:

- The Romanian delegation requested an item under "any other business" on the growth of large carnivore populations.
- The Latvian delegation requested an item under "any other business" on the adverse weather conditions and the need for certain derogations within the framework of the CAP.

The SCA subsequently agreed that these 2 items would be held in public session in accordance with article 8(2) of the rules of procedure of the Council.

The incoming Spanish Presidency informed the SCA about the next SCA meetings on 10 and 17 July and the "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting on 25 July 2023.
