Subject:	Attendance of third parties at the informal videoconference of the members of the Working Party on International Food and Agricultural Questions (FAO) on 18 July 2023 <i>- Approval</i>

1. The Presidency intends to invite the following third parties at the informal videoconference of the members of the Working Party on International Food and Agricultural Questions (FAO) scheduled for 18 July 2023:
 - the Director of the FAO Liaison Office with the European Union and Belgium in Brussels;
 - the Director of the UN Food Systems Coordination Hub, hosted by the FAO, accompanied by a liaison officer of the FAO Liaison Office with the European Union and Belgium.
2. The purpose of the attendance of the above persons at the Working Party meeting is:
 - as far as the Director of the FAO Liaison Office is concerned, to allow him to present the priorities of the FAO for the coming six months and to allow for an exchange of views with the Working Party members;
 - as far as the Director of the UN Food Systems Coordination Hub is concerned, to allow him to share information on the upcoming 'UN Food Systems Stocktaking Moment' (Rome, 24-26 July 2023) and to allow for an exchange of views with the Working Party members.
