Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 10.8.2023 derogating from Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/891 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council for the year 2023 as regards the value of marketed production, the national strategy and the recovery of Union financial assistance for multiannual commitments in the fruit and vegetables sector due to adverse meteorological events. <i>- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act</i>

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 173 of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2013. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 21 August 2023, the Council may object to it until 22 October 2023.
2. On 4 September 2023, the Special Committee on Agriculture (SCA) confirmed the outcome of the silence consultation launched on 21 August 2023 by which delegations considered there were no grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act. The SCA also agreed to inform the Parliament and the Commission, prior to the expiry of the period for objecting.

3. Therefore the SCA suggests that the Council, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 227(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013.
