b) PSC certificate

Only in case a PSC certificate for the delegate concerned has not yet been transmitted to the GSC Security Clearances Office, a copy should be sent by National Security Authority or other competent national authority or your organisation's security officer to security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu also by **Friday, 22 September 2023, 12:00.**

It is in the interest of the participants to ensure that their PSC certificate has not expired.

Please note that PSC certificate sent by the delegates themselves will not be accepted.

During the discussion of the **SECRET UE/EU SECRET** item, all electronic devices must be left in the lockers outside the meeting room.
