Dear Madam,

I refer to my previous notification on 16 June 2022 where I informed you, on behalf of the Icelandic government, that Iceland accepts the content of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing, as part of the Integrated Border Management Fund, the Instrument for Financial Support for Border Management and Visa Policy. The acceptance was based on Article 8 paragraph 2(b) of the Agreement concluded by the Council of the European Union and the Republic of Iceland and the Kingdom of Norway concerning the latters' association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen Acquis as Iceland had yet to fulfill constitutional requirements. I can hereby confirm that constitutional requirements have been fulfilled.
Consequently, I wish to inform you that Iceland accepts the contents of the aforementioned Regulation in accordance with Article 8 paragraph 2(a) of the said Agreement.

The Icelandic Mission to the European Union avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union the assurances of its highest consideration.
